Textbook and Library Returns

It is the student's responsibility to return all textbooks and library books.

- In order to get into an examination room to write your exam, you will need to return your textbook.
- Students report to their exam classroom 15 minutes before the start of their exam to hand in their textbook(s). Students that do not have their book must report to the office. The student will be given an exam entrance ticket from the office and will be allowed entry to the exam room. Students arriving late because of textbook issues will not be given extra time for the exam.

Examinations

- All final examinations must be written on the day and at the time shown on the exam schedule. Students with problems or **conflicts must see Mr. Sanderson.** **It is the student's responsibility to be in the right place at the right time.** Please know your course code and section number.
- From January 27 to February 2, 2010 students are required to be in school only when they must write an examination. Students are not to visit other schools during the examination period. This is considered trespassing.
- Students must leave books, coats, etc. in their lockers. Only pens, pencils, etc. may be brought into the exam room. Calculators may be used only if the instructions at the top of the exam so state. No talking is allowed during the exam period.
- Students writing Grade 9 and 10 exams will be required to remain in the exam room until the official conclusion of the examination period. All other students will be required to remain until the end of the first hour of the examination period. **No one will be allowed to leave during the last ten (10) minutes of any exam.**
- Students who are ill should have their parents call the school on the day of the exam to inform the school of the nature of the problem. **A doctor's certificate must follow no later than February 2, 2010.**
- The Library will be open for quiet study during exams. Students who wish to talk, eat or study in groups may use the cafeteria. All other areas of the school should be avoided.
- Halls are to be kept clear during exams. If you are permitted to leave an exam early, go to your locker quietly and then leave quickly. Other students who are writing exams are not to be disturbed. All students should be out of the school by 3:15 p.m.

Policy Statement On Students Who Are Late For Examinations

- All students who are late must report directly to the Main Office.
- Students who are less than fifteen minutes late will be permitted to write with their class. No additional time will be allotted.
- Students who are more than fifteen minutes late will be sent to an alternate supervised location. Students will be allotted either the remaining time or 2/3 of the scheduled time (whichever is longer) to write the examination.
- No student will be allowed to begin an examination once the other students writing the same examination have been permitted to leave the exam room, unless approval is given by the Administration.

Yellow School Bus Routes During Exams

- Regular Morning Pick Up – pick up times are posted in the Main Office and Student Lounge
- 2 Bus Routes → leave time from school is at 10:45 a.m. and is also the return loop for afternoon exams
- Buses will run at regular time at the end of the day.
- **“Special” Bus Routes** will be posted in the Main Office, Student Lounge and Main Foyer.
